

WELCOME, REV. VIACHESLAV RYMSKYI

Today our guest preacher is **Rev. Viacheslav Rymskyi** (known as Slavik), an ordained minister in the Evangelical Church of Odessa region, Ukraine. Slavik holds a degree in Public Administration and volunteered as a city council member. He provided paralegal services in Ukraine and also served as a church deacon and administrator. Slavik's father, also a minister, had just opened a new church facility three days before the Russian invasion.

In Ukraine, Slavik and his wife Sasha provided aide to foster care families and operated a ministry to support orphans and other children in need. When the war broke out, Slavik made urgent arrangements to evacuate his family to the United States.

Slavik coordinates the charitable project Serve Ukraine, which provides desperately needed humanitarian supplies to Ukraine and assists displaced Ukrainian families scattered all across Europe. Slavik and Sasha love the Lord and describe themselves as servants of Jesus. Welcome to Trinity, Rev. Rymskyi and family!
