Order your Boston Butts and Hams! Prepay by November 12; pick-up is November 19, 4:30-7 PM. Order forms are located beside the bulletins.

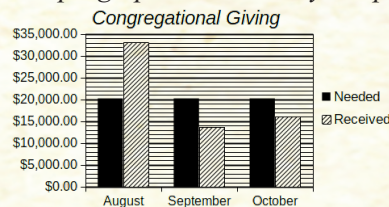
OTHER ANNOUNCEMENTS

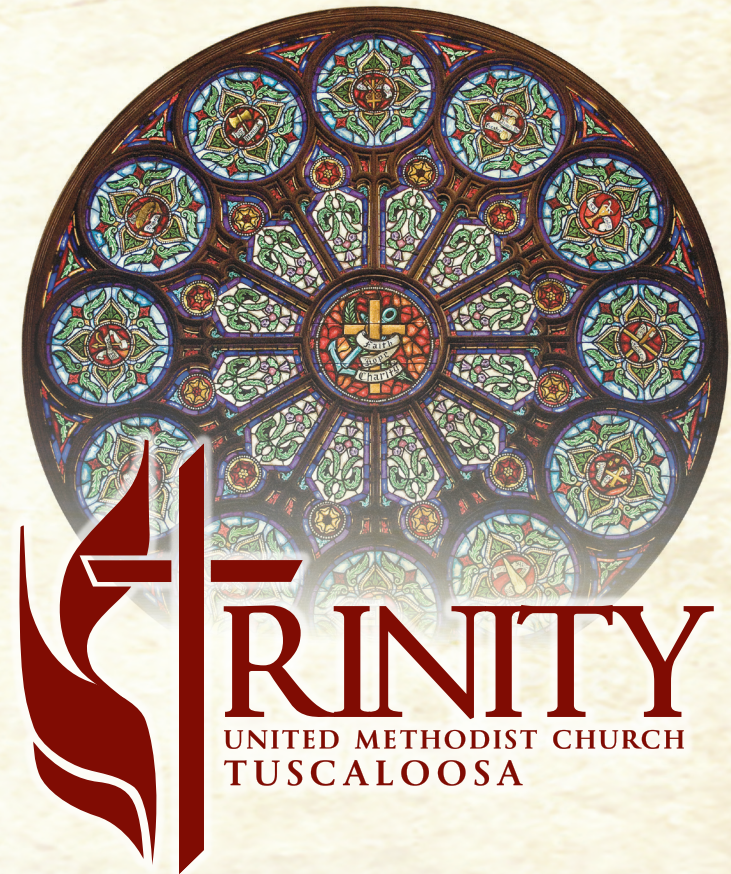
